4. Chalet Guests:

We have had a few requests for non-reunion guests to come with their Aggressor host to the AirShow Chalet. Folks, we are expecting at least 200 reunion members to be within the Chalet confines, which we will also share with the airshow performers and our active-duty Aggressors. Our chalet is designed for 250 people. We will certainly give priority to our registered members (who have paid for this Chalet) and current Aggressors, but we know that sharing this experience is also important.

We ask that if you are contemplating bringing a guest to the Friday Airshow and want to have access to the Chalet that you please keep the number to a minimum. Realize that depending on occupancy, we may have to cut off non-registered guest access. We will also ask that you make a "donation" to the Aggressor Association of \$20 per guest. Please note: this does NOT apply to our Active-Duty current Aggressors nor their immediate family. The Aggressor Association BOD reserves the right to waive all the above if the situation allows us to open as appropriate.

For your guests, you may also purchase a \$75 Friday Only pass which would allow them to also join in the fun at Roll Call. Or you could purchase a full Weekend ticket and they could enjoy the whole Aggressor Reunion experience.

Please also note: the Nellis Airshow will continue Saturday and Sunday when it opens to the public. The Aggressor Chalet is currently planned to be open, and I expect MUCH less crowded. While the squadrons may be enjoying their family day at the Chalet, there should be plenty of room for Reunion Registered Aggressors and their guests.

On Friday, the Chalet will have a cash bar, tables, and chairs set up in the tent and chairs set up in an outdoor viewing area to enjoy the show. The food plan is still in the works, but at the least, we will have snacks and sandwiches available.

5. Sahara Rooms:

We currently have 15 rooms still available at the group rate. However, the Sahara, per contract, will pull unused rooms on Monday, 3 Oct. After that date, any rooms will be by availability only and at the current rates. So, if you need a room, don't delay any longer.

We plan to have an "Aggressor Reunion" check-in table located in the lobby of the Sahara Hotel by the hotel registration desk on Thursday, 3 Nov from 1200-1900. Our plan is to have your individual reunion packet with all your goodies that you can pick up, either at check-in or in the Hospitality Room or Friday night at Roll Call.
